## WASTE MANAGEMENT POLICY

#### Preamble:

The College has designed methods for the management of waste generated in the campus using the basic waste management strategy of 4R's: Refuse, Reduce, Reuse and Recycle i.e.,

Refuse to buy wasteful or non-recyclable products

Reduce the amount of waste generated,

Reuse everything to its maximum after proper segregation and cleaning.

Recycle: Keeping things which can be Recycled aside and handed over to appropriate agencies.

The waste generated in the campus includes liquid waste and solid waste- both of biodegradable and non-biodegradable nature & chemical waste. No classified hazardous waste is generated in the campus. The environmental policy of the institute is to achieve zero discharge and complete utilization of waste with well-designed strategies to make campus clean, hygienic and healthy.

# Waste Management Policy Statement:

The College is committed to manage waste produced in an environmentally safe, cost-effective and timely manner in line with current environmental legislation. The college shall comply with the Waste Management Rules as prescribed by the Government.

The policy includes the following:

- 1. The College shall safely dispose entire solid and liquid waste produced in the campus,
- 2. Top the use of 'single use' plastics on campus using a combination of alternative materials,
- 3. Ban on use or sale of plastic bottled water on campus
- 4. Recover and ensure proper disposal of e-waste
- 5. Reuse the RO waste water.

#### Scope:

The scope of this policy shall cover the solid (including papers, plastics, e-waste) and waste water generated in the campus. It shall be applicable to all employees (faculty and staff), students, guests and others visiting the campus.

### **Policy Objectives:**

The objectives of this policy are:

To confirm that waste management is performed in accordance with all waste legislative requirements, including the duty of care, and to plan for future legislative changes and to mitigate their effects.

To reduce waste generation at source and facilitate repair, reuse and recycling over the disposal of wastes in a cost effective manner.

To provide obviously defined roles and responsibilities to identify and coordinate each activity of the waste management. To endorse environmental awareness to increase and motivate waste minimization, reuse and recycling.

To devote to the expansion of recycling opportunities on the college campus and to transform waste into valued products.

To ensure safe handling and storage of wastes in the college premises.

To provide appropriate training to teachers, residents, staff, students and other stakeholders on waste management issues.

Encouraging an integrated approach to waste management in the campus.
